

KSA Diploma Transition Policy

Current as of 11 August 2015

- This policy is to clarify the expectations and requirements of KSA students currently enrolled in HLT42812 Certificate IV in Kinesiology and HLT51507 Diploma of Kinesiology.
- The policy is based on the two General Directions issued by ASQA on January 1 2014 and April 1 2015.
- Students should clarify their enrolment date with their college to ensure they meet the requirements in the appropriate time frame.

Withdrawal of HLT42812 Certificate IV in Kinesiology (proposed date Dec 2015)

- KSA will provide all Cert IV students the opportunity to complete their Cert IV in their contracted time frame.
- An extension can be granted to a maximum of two years.
- After the two years all remaining Certificate IV students must be transitioned into the new diploma.
- The final date for issuing students with Cert IV transition Cert IV students is Dec 2017
- Students may continue to complete their Cert IV before the final date AND be enrolled in the HLT52415 Diploma.

Superseded HLT51507 Diploma in Kinesiology - 6th August 2015

- Students enrolled in the HLT51507 Diploma prior to 1 April 2015 will have the opportunity to complete their Diploma in their contracted time frame.
- A maximum of 18 months extension can be granted to complete their diploma or they must be transitioned into the new HLT52415 Diploma.
- An extension fee may apply.
- The final date for issuing students with the HLT51507 diploma is 6th February 2017.
- The final date for transitioning students into HLT52415 diploma 6th February 2017.

Table 1 (below) outlines KSA's workshops and home-study units and how they can be transitioned to the new Diploma qualification.

- Column A are units studied in current KSA Diploma.
- Column B are units that can be RPL'ed (transitioned) to the new Diploma.
- Column C are the units for the new Diploma.
